Coyle will be celebrated on Friday, August 9 at 12:10 p.m. at the Cathedral of Saint Paul (2120 3rd Avenue North in Birmingham) followed by a reception. Father Coyle was shot and fatally wounded on August 11, 1921 as he sat in the swing on his rectory front porch by an enraged minister after Father Coyle presided at the minister's daughter's wedding to a Puerto Rican man, Pedro Gussman, two hours prior.
