## Sunday, April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025 **Father Reju Pynadath J. Celebrate God's Mercy**

John 8:1-11

We all have seen rosaries made of a thread. The specialty of those rosaries is that, there is only one, single thread and very many beads are added to that same thread. The same way, today the mother Church gives us three readings having the same thread. And we can say that this thread is God's mercy.

The first reading is from prophet Isaiah. The Lord is telling the people to forget the past. In the past God showed His military power. Even the Israelites were kind of sinners throughout their life. But the Lord is forgiving them all their transgressions. Now the Lord is telling them to forget everything of their past as He is going to start a new. He is demanding them to start a new life! The Lord in His Mercy is preparing a way in the desert and is putting water in the desert for his people to drink. The Lord is forgetting the transgressions of Israelites and is preparing a better future out of His Mercy. And so now people has to forget their old, sinful ways of life and start a new way of life that is loyal to the Lord of Mercy!

Today's second reading is from St Paul's letter to the Philippians. As we all know, Paul has a notorious background as far as Church and Jesus are concerned. He was a member of the team that stoned the First Martyr Steven (Acts 7:58.) He was very active in persecuting the church. He might have had the benefits of those duties. But today Paul is saying he would like to forget his past. He is so sharply focused on the things to come, heaven. Paul is praising the Lord for forgiving all his transgressions of the past life. And this is a new life for him, a life focused only on the eternal life.

In today's Gospel (John 8:1-11) we have the story of the woman caught in adultery. The entire crowd, for varieties of reasons, is without any mercy to this woman. She is trapped so wisely that even her partner is found missing! There is no one to defend her. She is presented as if she never deserved any mercy. And we know that Jesus is showing her undue mercy. He is there to defend her and save her from the brutal hands. He is forgiving her past and asks her to forget her own past sinful ways of life and start a new. She is given the challenge 'not to sin anymore'!

In the abundance of His unconditional Mercy, He is able to forgive us all the sins of our past life. We must thank and praise God for His Mercy. For in the first reading, we see even the wild beasts praise and honor God. All the three readings help us to be convinced of the abundance of God's mercy that is undeserved by and unconditional to us.

We could be celebrating God's mercy for we are forgiven unconditionally. We are left with a challenge 'not to sin anymore.' Let us start a new life with hope and trust in the Lord. God Bless and Guide you all......Amen
