# Sunday May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024 **Reflections for Sixth Easter Sunday,**

#### Words of the Holy Father

But this is a blank cheque: "whatever you ask the Father in my name, I will give to you"! God is a friend, an ally, a spouse. *In prayer one can establish an intimate* relationship with him, so much so that in the "Our Father" Jesus taught us to address to him a series of questions. We can ask God everything, everything; explain everything, recount everything. It does not matter if we feel flawed in our relationship with God: we are not good friends, we are not grateful children, we are not faithful spouses. He continues to love us. It is what Jesus shows definitively at the Last Supper when he says: "This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood" (Lk 22:20). With that gesture in the Upper Room, Jesus foreshadows the mystery of the Cross. God is a faithful ally: if men and women cease to love him, he nevertheless continues to love, even if love leads him to Calvary. God is always close to our heart's door and he waits for us to open it to him.
