#### SERMON ON THE PLAIN

# Two Ways of Life to Choose Luke 6:17, 20-26

Today's first reading is from prophet Jeremiah. Jeremiah lived approximately from 650 - 570 BCE. Invasion of Jerusalem by Babylon and the following Babylon Exile happened in 587 BCE. Jeremiah knows Jerusalem prior to and after this invasion. Prior to this invasion Jerusalem relied heavily upon its own military strength and economic and diplomatic powers. After this invasion, prophet Jeremiah says that the one who trusts in human beings and whose heart is away from the Lord is a cursed person. This is a way of life. And that is the fate of Jerusalem.

The second way of life is that of the blessed one. He is the one who trusts in the Lord and the Lord will always foster him.

In the second reading St. Paul also speaks of two ways of life. One is life of faith; believing in Jesus and in His Resurrection. Those who choose this way of life will have eternal life. Second way of life is that of a non-believer; denying Jesus and His Resurrection. And they would inherit death.

In today's Gospel again, Jesus is speaking about two ways of life. One could be living relying solely on material comfort, human resources and temporary /worldly satisfactions. According to Jesus they are the cursed ones, for their fortune would be overturned in the Kingdom. Wealth, position, success, good fortune etc are not evil in themselves. But they caution us against placing our trust in them instead of God.

On the other side, blessed are those who place their trust in God. Those are the people relying on God. And God will foster them.

Thus, all these three readings of the day, present before us a basic truth of life on earth: 'It is a choice between either way of life.' We all could be trusting either on human beings and this worldly temporary satisfactions or on God. Our destiny depends upon our own choices. Jesus has made it clear in Matthew 6:24 that "No one can serve two masters;" therefore a choice is a must.

God may help and guide us to place our trust upon Him that we all may inherit Heaven, Amen!

# REPARATION NOVENA VIGIL
